Today's program was presented by Connie Grubermann, Club Treasurer of the local Zonta club, who discussed Zonta Intrenational(ZI), and Peggy Milton, past President of the local club, who talked about some of the

programs of ZI and the activities of the local club. Introducing them was our own Cindy Rogers, who serves as the President of the local club. ZI is a global organization of professionals charged with empowering


women worldwide thru service and advocacy. It began in 1919 and there are 30,000 members from 67 countries. Their vision is to envision a world where women's rights are recognized and every woman is able to achieve



her full potential. Gender Equality is one of the goals. The local club was formed in 1998 and they work at raising funds and doing such great things as supplying clothing and birthing kits to needy women. They also provide food to single mothers and elderly women on Thanksgiving. Their annual fundraiser this year is called Boots and Bling and will be Saturday August 27 at 6:30 PM at Bloemsma Farm Barn, 1145 Patton Road in Franklin. There is an excellent website under Zonta International where more information can be obtained. The dues collected from it's members is used to cover administrative expenses and all donations are spent on their programs. One of the programs funded by ZI is the Prevention of Root



Causes thru Education, which tries to eliminate female discrimination thru awareness and education. Another program is Delay in Early Marriage in Niger, where it is common practice for parents to force their young daughters to marry at an early age instead of completing school. ZI also provides scholarships for women interested in pursuing a career in aviation and aerospace, scholarships to women with promising careers in the business field, and scholarships to women with leadership skills who intend to work in the public sector.

#### **Club Approves 2016-17 Budget!**


President –Elect Lenny Jordan presented the board approved budget before the club on Wednesday and the club formally gave approval. We are also excited to announce that we were

with an RI Club Central Award for her club work with the RI website in 2013-14. Great work Nancie!!




