The Read2Me Program was established in Macon County in late 2011. This program is geared toward helping children get an early start by encouraging parents to read to them outside of school. This program provides books to children from birth to 5 years of age. The program is geared toward preschool age children, but is quickly involving children of all ages.

There are approximately 4,500 elementary school age children in K-8. This year the Read2Me program held a writing contest for these students who wished to participate. The topics were: The Greatest President and If I Were President. There were 78 essays submitted. The 1st place winner and their teacher (to be used for school supplies) would win \$50. The second place winner and their teacher would win \$25. There was an Honorable Mention named, as well.

Relay for Life


