## **Christmas Party Celebration**






The Rotary Club of Franklin and

Jeff Gillette receives his Paul Harris Fellow pin. Jeff is the sonin-law of Clayton Ramsay who received his plus three pin.



## **Christmas Wreaths**


Charlie Vargas, Cub Master of Pack 263 and Scout Master for Boy Scout Troop 202,

Things You'll Never Hear In A Western




- "Y'know, Badlands Pete... a roaring campfire, good coffee, nice prairie


