CART Cruise Scheduled

This weeklong cruise will give cruisers an opportunity to learn more about Alzheimer's Disease research, to share ideas and strategies to support CART, and to raise some funds for CART. In addition, we will be able to enjoy the warm weather of the southern Caribbean during the winter of 2018.

Norwegian Cruise Line has agreed to donate \$100 to CART for each passenger that books a voyage. Each club will receive credit for the \$100 generated by their members and any friends and family going along with them. Norwegian has also added some excellent incentives for this cruise. 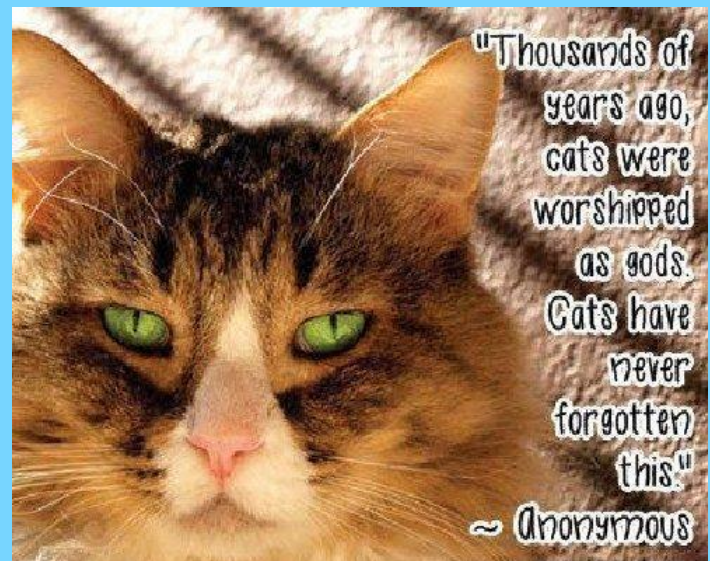
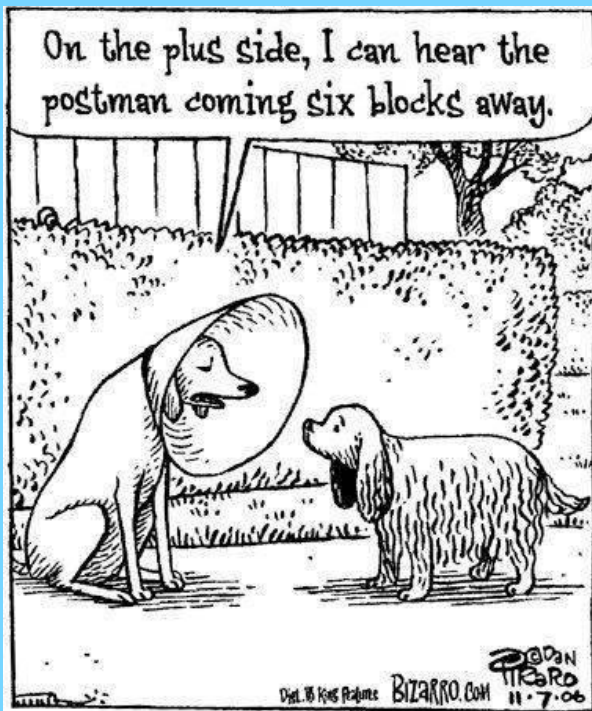
