Our Library system offers an array of programs for children and their parents including a separate area dedicated to children with monthly themes and programs geared to interest that target group. 
standing progress of Read2Me. The Club recognized them with a Family and Community Award for their service to the community and its children. Read2Me collects and disperses books to children (target group is birth to third grade), and conducts parent education on the importance of reading and easy, everyday ways of showing your child how important it is to see their parents read and just to be familiar with books. This year, Read2Me partnered with the Western Mountains Reading Council, the Fontana Regional Library, the Literacy Council of Highlands,

GSE Team from India for March 27th Meeting




