The Philippine Friendship Team provided today's program. Stacy Guffey introduced Elenita "Ellen" Landicho, team leader, who introduced the members of the group.



Our next 4 Way Test at Macon Middle is tomorrow. Rotarians please plan to arrive **no later than 8:00 AM.**


We are in need of volunteers for upcoming sessions in October and November. Please come and help make the difference in a young person's life. See club chair Amy Man-shack if you would like to participate.


