- Cannot Turn off the street lamps
- ◆ There will additional Law Enforcement, EMS, and AMC Hospital Staff for the event—beginning 8/17
- ◆ Information Booth located on the square with a viewing station @ Town Hall
- ◆ There will be an Emergency Command Post at The Gazebo
