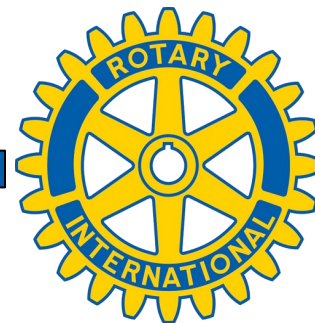

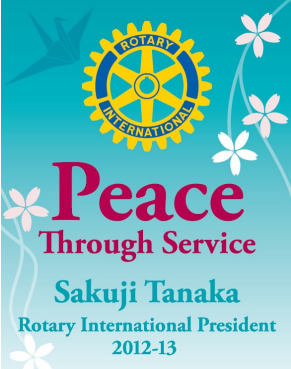
## Shop With a Cop Scores!

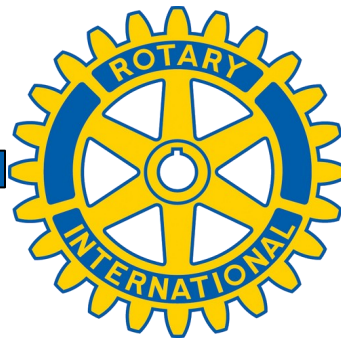

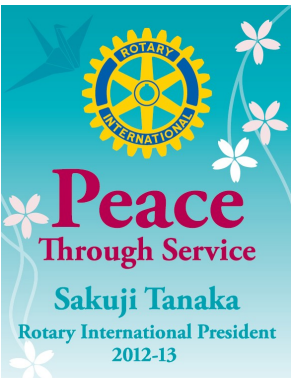

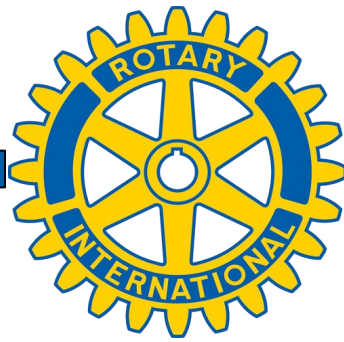
