Our program this week, in recognition of Rotary Water and Sanitation Month, was given to us by Doug Johnson and Mike Breedlove and Jeffrey Epps from



the Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD). SWCD lends technical and educational assistance to interested citizens of Macon County and provides monetary assistance, when available, to interested landowners to install Best Management Practices (BMPs) in order to reduce soil erosion and improve water quality.

The SWCD provide a number of State and Local programs including: North Carolina Agricultural Cost-Share Program (NCASP), Little Tennessee Stream and Riparian Restoration Program, Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP), Western NC EQIP Stream Initiative, Community Conservation Assistance Program (CCAP), Voluntary Ag District (VAD) Program. They also conduct a number of educational programs within the community: Conservation Field Day, Poster and Essay Contest, and Stream Erosion Example Tables.

The SWCD is also responsible for monitoring erosion, sedimentation, and water quality issues; Flooding and floodplain encroachment; Steep slopes and landslide plains; Unstable stream bank. The Soil and Water Conservation District also continues to address growing problems in our county such as: Stream Restoration, Riparian Buffer Establish-



ment, CCAP Program, Fencing for livestock exclusion, and Stream crossing and Culverts.

Thank you Doug, Mike and Jeffrey for all you do to protect our soil and water quality in Macon County!
