too late to contact Patsy about an item to donate and no gift would be considered too small.


Also, our Caribbean cruise raffle will be announced Saturday evening and tickets will go on sale for the first time. We will be raffling a week long, exterior cabin

Franklin handing out literature on our Club's activi-


ties. Several hundred turned out in the rain on Saturday.

a chance to win a cruise! The tickets will also be sold at the BBQ Festival, Riverfest and Rotary Day in August and Fair in September. The cruise will be given


away the last day of the fair.




### Member Profile-Sean Gibson, Club President-Elect


