Rotarians got a general overview of the 2nd most populated country in the world, a nation that has a parliamentary government and weddings that last for several days. Among those speaking to the group was team leader, Neeraj Sogani from the Rotary Club of Jaipur Central. Neeraj's is a retired Army officer and currently works in the automobile industry. Over the last twelve years in Rotary, he has been involved in water management for his region. Neeraj is presently an assistant district governor. Neeraj has a passion for wanting to interact with different people

in different cultures. Team member Krishna Mehta, a lawyer from Ahmedabad, shared her daily life with members, she is sponsored by a Rotary Club of 40 members. Krishna is known nationally and regionally in her country as a dynamic public speaker. Team member Vinay Kothari, a lawyer and sponsored by the Rotary Club of Jodhpur South, resides in the southern part of the country. Vinay enjoys the great outdoors including hiking. 


and has published 14 international research papers. Chhavi Rajawat, an elected head of council in Soda and from the Rotary Jaipur South Club shared her passion of helping im-



prove water conditions and a way of life in her region. She is also has been named one of the top twenty young women professionals in India.










This past weekend President Elect Nancie, President Nominee Susie, John Yermack, and Gary Bray attended Presi-

This means that for the first time ever the school has electrical lights and the potential to have computers for the students. A small team (6 of us) are leaving in less than a month to visit Panama. This time Elizabeth is going with me, and we will be hopefully "wrapping up" the Rotary International Matching Grant that we received last year.

While the school now has electrical power they do not have any computers. If anyone has an older laptop that they can donate we will transport it to the school and the students. Last year we were able to provide 7 laptops to Kenia and her students. Two or three for Tierra Oscura would be excellent but we can carry six!!!! 
