



Community Care Clinic Needs You by Sean Gibson

Almost ten years ago a community clinic was originally opened in Highlands geared to toward providing community members who cannot afford health insurance to get proper healthcare. At that time a vast number of people that used the community clinic were from Franklin. Then in 2010, the Community Care Clinic in Franklin was opened. The clinic today has the same objective in mind...serving those that cannot afford health insurance and healthcare as well as medications.

On June 5th, 2013 Community Care Clinic Director Franklin Ingram spoke to Rotary Club of Franklin members about the clinic's need for financial assistance as well as hands on volunteers. When the clinic opened, it was funded by a state grant that expired on December 31st, 2012. The clinic cannot get the grant again. Ingram, who has a long career in managing non profits, told members that without a care clinic, it would be detrimental to the more than 1700 that have been served by the clinic here in Macon County over the last three


years. The clinic provides medications at no charge or at a discounted charge to the community, which would also be eliminated if the clinic no longer exists. The Rotary Club of Franklin has been involved in financially helping the clinic and the clinic is looking for volunteers to help out. make this weekly newsletter possible.




Dental Clinic Needs You!
