Habitat for Humanity was founded in 1976 and is a Christian Organization (non-denominational). Their main goal and objective as an organization is to help those that don't have the resources or ability to help themselves with home repair and home alterations. They do many projects concerning handicapped accessibility with organizations and homeowners.



The Habitat for Humanity here in Franklin serves both the Macon and Jackson communities. Currently, this chapter sits in the Top 50 in the Nation in per capita donated time and repairs! This year alone Habitat for Humanity helped 46 families with home repairs and maintenance issues. They also helped a number of non-profit organizations. They aim to build one home per year in our area.


