Troop 202 Re-Charter



Our Rotary club presented troop 202, one of the oldest troops in WNC, with a check for \$1000 towards their fundraising efforts for the year. Dr. Vargas let us know that Troop 202 was chartered in 1933 and is the 2nd oldest troop in WNC. They meet in the Slagle building every Monday, and their troop is trying to make improvements to this building.

Troop 202 GAINED 12 new scouts this year! Which means they are able to break out into patrols, which is what the scout troops should be able to do. These patrol groups have one leader and 3 scouts. This way, more scouts learn these valuable leadership skills!

Troop 202 is planning on departing for their Philmont trip on July 15th, with 6 scouts and four adults attend. Many of the trails are scheduled to be shut down due to raging forest fires in the area until July 13th. Dr. Vargas has suggested to Boy Scouts of America that they still be able to attend Philmont but assist in the clean-up and rebuilding phase.

Lastly, Troop 202's Unit Commissioner presented President Judy with the Re-Charter for the year where she, and we as the Rotary Club of Franklin pledged to assist Troop 202 with needs that may arise through the year. The troop also pledged to our club that they would uphold their values as scouts, and up their community service efforts.


