Vic Perry:

Clerk of Superior Court

Our own Vic Perry gave us a great and informational program on the duties and responsibilities of a Clerk of Superior Court. Vic is a native of Macon County and graduated from Western Carolina University. He has worked in the court system for 17 years and was first elected in 2006, and since been re-elected twice and is running again this year un-opposed.

The Clerk of Superior Courts is not a county office, but rather is an office of the State. The State agency of Administrator of the Courts covers Macon County's budget, supplies with office needs and tech support. Vic's office has nine employees (not including himself): three Assistant Clerks, which have that same authorization as a clerk, and 6 Deputy Clerks who preform ministerial duties.



Vic and his team have three areas of focus: Criminal Law, Civil Actions, and Special Proceedings. Vic detailed for our club the Ceding of Estates, Guardianship and Competencies, and Special Proceedings. It was astonishing to hear how much his office and employees handle on a daily and weekly basis. Thank you Vic for presenting to our club and letting us glimpse the amazing work your team does daily!
