Franklin Police Chief David Adams

Chief Adams is originally from Hendersonville, happily married with two sons! He served in the Army in the 82nd Airborne Division and also served in Dessert Storm. He has a Masters in Leadership and has been with the Franklin PD for 6 years now.

Chief Adams gave us an update on the progress the PD has made in the last six years with a focus on the past years goals and achievements:

*The Franklin PD is currently at full-staff with 18 employees

- *This year the department began workplace and active shooter drills at local businesses
- *RAD (Rape, Aggression and Defense) Class for women only 2 trainings annually

*Coffee with a Cop – 2 meetings annually

- *The PD has set up permanent Child Restraint Training and offer anyone a child restraint safety check free of charge. They also have approved car seats if in need.
- *Narcan training for every officer Each patrol vehicle has Narcan
- *10+ of their officers have college degrees
- *Very high retention rate for officers, most staying through their careers
- *BARS Training Free Alcohol Serving training at local restaurant and bars
- *Chief Adams feels that the most pressing issue for our community right now is the drug problem:
 - -Feels that stiffer penalties for selling drugs would curb distribution
 - -Stronger mental health resources
 - -A community effort to collaboratively address the issue is needed
