## Salute to Veterans

Mike Watson presented an outstanding Veterans' Day program. He started with the words Thank You and asked the question, "When do two words, eight letters, earn their stripes of as words of gratitude?"

"It happens when we put action and emotion behind the words. It happens when we look into someone's eyes and speak from our heart. It happens when we don't plan for it, but we are stirred to say it."

He then noted that of the 16 million who served in WWII, only 497,000 are still alive, but are leaving us daily-about 372/day. Our last WWI veteran died in 2011.

Mike closed with these words before recognizing the veterans, both the Rotary veterans as well as our many visitors:

"We honor these men and women most by living well and remembering that our ability to worship as we choose, move around this great country unrestricted, and to gather undisturbed with our families on Thanksgiving, are just a handful of the gifts given to us by those who have defended that freedom at a very heavy cost."

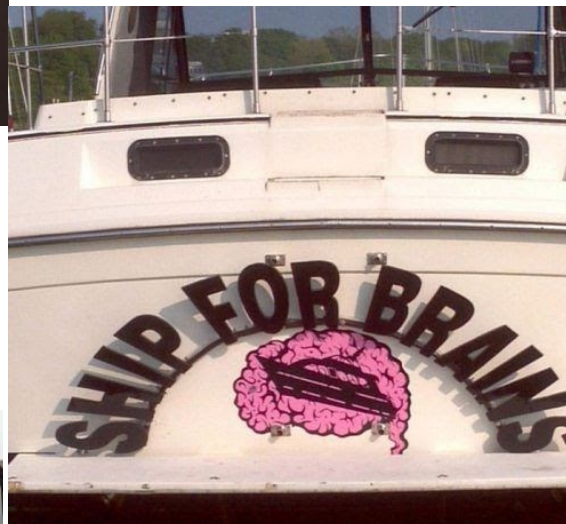

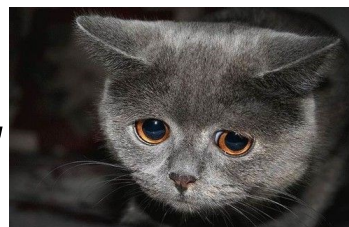
