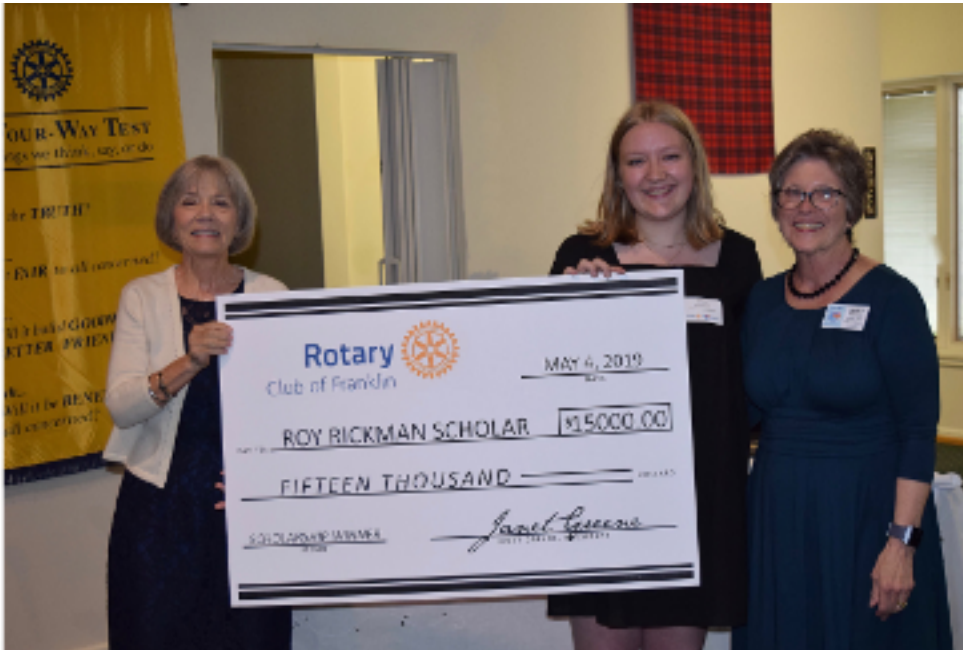
While in Sylva she's been attending Smoky Mountain H.S. She's been taking history, psychology, English and has participated in a couple of plays. After school she has even played a little softball.

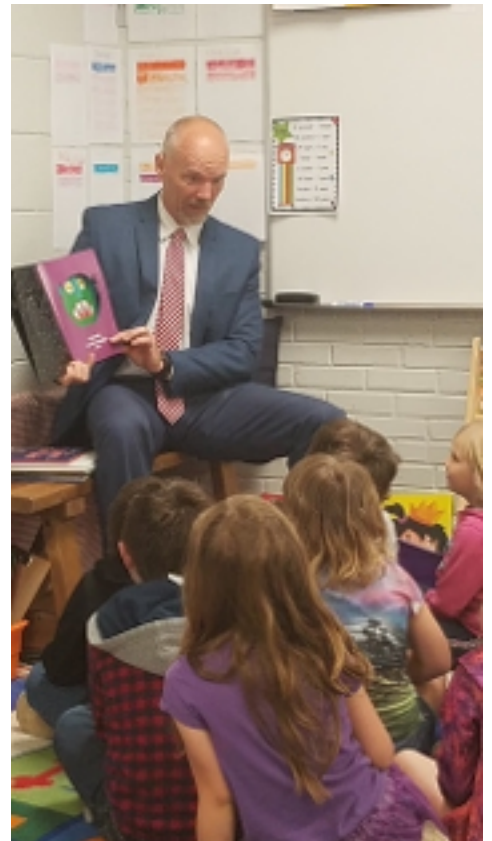

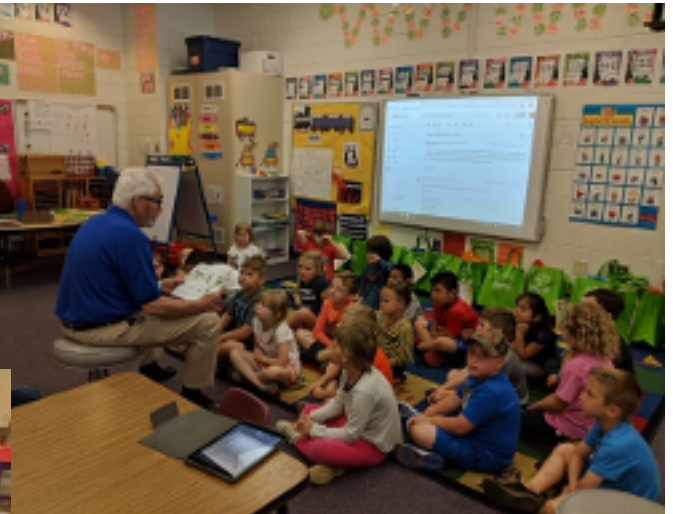
